Public meeting will address closure of Mandan remediation site

BISMARCK, N.D. – The Mandan Remediation Trust (MRT) will meet on Wednesday Jan. 22, 2020 to discuss closure of the Mandan remediation site. This advisory body oversees the remediation of petroleum contamination first discovered underground in downtown Mandan in 1984.

The MRT meeting will be held in the Veterans Conference Room at the Mandan City Hall located at 205 2nd Ave NW, Mandan, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

A brief history and progress report of the remediation process will be provided, as well as the proposed plan for site closure.
